Interpreting for Early Childhood Screening and Intervention

Practical skills for interpreting developmental screening and evaluation in early childhood

WORKSHOP DESCRIPTION

Early childhood screening and intervention meetings focus on a young child's development, milestones, and possible delays. These conversations often include structured screening questions, developmental terminology, explanations of evaluation results, and recommendations for services.

This workshop prepares interpreters to work confidently in early childhood settings, including screenings, developmental evaluations, and early intervention meetings. Participants will learn how these appointments are structured, what providers typically ask, and how developmental concerns and results are discussed. Through guided discussion and role play practice, interpreters will build confidence and practical skills for assignments in early childhood screening and intervention appointments.

KEY OBJECTIVES

By the end of this workshop, participants will be able to:

- Explain the purpose and basic process of early childhood screening and intervention services
- Identify common developmental domains and terminology used in screening and evaluation meetings
- Apply ethical standards and maintain professional boundaries in complex and sensitive discussions
- Use practical strategies to prepare for early childhood screening and intervention interpreting assignments
- Interpret screening questions and conversations about developmental evaluation results
